Bus Orientation

Clients receive direct instruction and assistance to navigate public transit.
*** Limited capacity during COVID-19*

Learner's Permit Support

Clients receive step-by-step information about the driver's license process and language-accessible study resources to prepare for the learner's permit knowledge test at DMV. Curriculum is drawn from the VA driver's manual, is geared to English language learners, and has been endorsed by a DMV-certified local driving school.

DMV Orientation + Navigation Support

Clients receive direct instruction and assistance to navigate the DMV, access DMV services independently, and move forward in the driver's license process.

Behind the Wheel Support

Clients receive direct assistance to schedule behind the wheel driving lessons with a DMV-certified local driving school.

English Tutor

Clients are matched with a trained volunteer interested in providing English language tutoring and conversation practice. Volunteers and clients typically meet one time per week. Offered virtually or in-person (when able).

Health + Wellness Mentor

Clients are matched with a trained volunteer to support their self-determined wellness goals.

Mentor

Clients are matched with a trained volunteer interested in providing support specific to client goals like learner's permit preparation, citizenship preparation, and other educational and employment goals.

*** Does not include crisis support.*

Health + Wellness Groups

Clients participate in peer groups to develop a stronger social network, engage in activities, and learn about resources in the community that address their self-determined wellness goals.

Heela Sewing Course

Clients receive instruction in machine sewing, with focus on skills required to obtain jobs and flourish in a sewing-related career. Classes are offered at both Beginner and Maker (advanced) levels. The Maker class is client driven and includes skill building for clients interested in designing and selling their own products.

Personal Finance Skills Seminars

Clients participate in virtual seminars addressing their personal financial skills goals. Seminar topics include banking and checking accounts, budgeting, credit and debit cards, tax literacy, and more.

Referral to Community Partners or Supporting Agencies

Clients with needs beyond the scope of our services receive connection to other community organizations or agencies that exist to these area/s of need.

*** All ReEstablish Richmond services cost money but are provided free to our clients. Our income streams include community partnerships, individual donors, and grants.*

*** Because ReEstablish Richmond is committed to ensuring language equity, interpretation is available for all programs.*

*** Due to public health concerns during COVID-19, all programs are offered virtually.*

*** Programs are limited to clients aged 18+ years old.*

*** ReEstablish Richmond has limited funding for emergency financial assistance, and priority is given to those who do not qualify for government assistance. More information is available in our referral form.*
