## HOW TO OBTAIN A DRIVER'S LICENSE IN VIRGINIA

TIPS ReEstablish RICHMOND

- BRING ALL REQUIRED DOCUMENTS , TO THE DMV (SEE CHECKLIST).
- DOCUMENTS MUST BE ORIGINAL; NO PHOTOCOPIES.
- THE SPELLING OF YOUR NAME SHOULD BE EXACTLY THE SAME ON ALL DOCUMENTS.
- IF YOU NEED GLASSES TO SEE CLEARLY AT A DISTANCE, BRING THEM TO DMV. IF YOU THINK YOU MIGHT NEED GLASSES, GET YOUR VISION TESTED BEFORE GOING TO DMV. (WALMART OR TARGET HAVE AFFORDABLE EYE EXAMS AND GLASSES.)
- FOR THE VISION TEST, YOU WILL NEED TO RECOGNIZE THE LETTERS OF THE ALPHABET. PRACTICE SAYING THE NAMES OF THE LETTERS OUT LOUD IN ENGLISH.

TAKE DRIVING LESSONS WITH A CERTIFIED INSTRUCTOR (\$250+) AND / OR PRACTICE DRIVING WITH A LICENSED DRIVER IN THE PASSENGER SEAT

COMPLETE A CERTIFIED DRIVER'S ED COURSE THAT INCLUDES ROAD SKILLS TEST AT A CERTIFIED LOCAL DRIVING SCHOOL (\$400+) AFTER <u>60 DAYS</u>, SCHEDULE ROAD SKILLS TEST APPOINTMENT AT DMV (IN ENGLISH)

## \*\* It is helpful to bring all the above documents (or as many as you have) to the DMV. It's better to have too many than not enough. \*\*

**Optional:** If you have an unexpired driver's license from your country, bring it to DMV. Showing your license when you apply to take the Learner's Permit test may enable you to schedule the road test immediately upon passing, instead of waiting 60 days. Must be original - no photocopies allowed. If your license or other official document used for proof is printed in a language other than French, German, or Spanish, you will also need to provide an English translation of the license.
