Please indicate in the volunteer application if prefer supporting pre-literate to beginner students or intermediate to advanced students. • Contribute to the client’s listening, speaking, reading, and writing skills in English. • Help the client understand the structure and rules of the English language. • Tailor lessons around goals that are practical and relevant to the client. • Provide constructive feedback for client on their progress. <p>RESPONSIBILITIES AND EXPECTATIONS:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Be reliable and develop a schedule so the client knows when to expect you. • Utilize resources provided in Volunteer Training and those on our Volunteer Portal to plan lessons that meet the client's goals and needs. • Since you’ll be matched for tutoring, make your boundaries clear if other needs come up. Some clients may present other documents or challenges they are facing. Let ReEstablish Richmond staff member know so they can provide the right support if available. • Consider your time with the client supplemental to their ESL classes and self-directed practice. • Client may ask for specific support based on their educational or employment goals. • Report your Volunteer hours via the Volunteer Portal once a month. <p>REQUIREMENTS / QUALIFICATIONS:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No foreign language skills necessary. • Patience to work slowly in a setting where obvious progress milestones may be infrequent or less obvious.
